



#### **Utilization A**

Utilization A is used with every set containing the same amount of Monkeys and tension belts. One Monkey incl. climbing hold is attached to each tension belt. The result is one climbing route, with holds and steps defined by the position of the Monkeys. With this utilization, it is possible to high up on the trees with relatively few Monkeys.



#### **Utilization B**

Utilization B is used with every set containing twice the number of Monkeys compared to tension belts. 2 Monkeys incl. climbing holds are attached to one tension belt. Several climbing routes are possible, because holds and steps are not defined by the position and can therefore be figured out individually. Utilization B tends to be easier to climb, because beginners can always use a second hold to stabilize themselves.

Regardless of utilization, we recommend using our Starter-Sets. It contains 4 Monkeys without holds and 2 tension belts and serves as an easy way to start the route.

It's time to introduce the perfect backpack for our Monkey-System. With the "OrangUtan" we managed to fulfill all the needs and whishes of our customers. Details, size, design – it's all there! In collaboration with renowned German manufacturer Tatonka, we can guarantee best materials and quality.

It is designed to carry 40 complete Monkeys. You can take along a rope and a helmet in the adjustable front compartment. Carabiners, runners etc. can be hung onto the gear loops.

Before setting up the Monkeys just remove the top. The big opening gives you a good overview over the stowed climbing holds. Zip on the removable flap on the back to protect the back from dirt. Now just clip a carabiner

to the upper handle and start setting up the trees.
The "OrangUtan" can be used as a carrying case too. Even on the beach it won't let you down.

We solely use holds of well known manufacturers. Their experience ensures high quality!

All of our holds are TÜV certified and comply with various norms (eg. DIN EN 12572-3; EN 1176.1). They are shatter proof, so that injuries by falling parts can be avoided.

Our holds are made of polyurethane and polyester, which are premium quality, non-toxic materials. Well suited for children.

Choosing our holds, we pay attention to an ergonomic fit. Because of their excellent features, best grip and low risk of injury due to overwork are granted.

The sizes of the holds specifically match our Monkeys. Hereby the risk of injuries caused by distant parts or sharp edges is minimized.

By using standardized length of screws, easy assembling without causing harm to the trees is guaranteed. No excess length on the back of the Monkey that could damage the bark. In addition, sufficient fixedness and therefore highest safety is assured.



## MONKEY® instruction manual and tips

(Please read carefully before use)

In order to have fun climbing, bouldering, training or having adventures with the Monkeys, we compiled several tips. Your creativity should certainly be accentuated and referring to that, we appreciate every advice you give us that improves the fun factor.



## Preparation:

The best way is to prepare the Monkeys at home in advance. The hold has to be placed in a way that guarantees maximum grip. Leaning a bit to the right is optimal (2 o'clock on a watch).



#### Choose a tree:

Make sure it is permitted to climb on the tree. In case the owner is anonymous, the forestry office will help. The thickest trees likely are the strongest. Beginners should preferably choose straight trees with few branches. If you can embrace the tree, you can apply the tension belts quickly. Remove all the items that might endanger your health. Consider that close-by trees may cause injuries.

#### Attach the tension belts:

Attach the belt, so that the buckle is pointing your way. This way, you can lean into it with your body to pull the belt tight later. If the belt can be pulled about 5cm from the bark in one position, it is attached correctly. Do not put more tension on the belt!

On our Homepage you can find a video how-to that shows the easiest way of setting up the Monkeys and explains what else to consider.

## **Attach the Monkeys:**

Grab the Monkeys on the lower part and position it right behind the towed belt, so you can put the belt in the therefore designed slot.

Carefully regard that the belt slides into the kerf. We recommend 1-2 Monkeys for each belt. After you attached the Monkeys, you position them in the desired way and frap the belt with full strength. Use your body as described. You can choose the gap between the several belts individually, but it is recommended to install them in between 35-55 cm (14-20 inches) depending on your body size and the desired difficulty. In case you placed the Monkeys on specific places like slick bark (and the like) and the belt does not guarantee the desired foothold, you can add a second belt on the lower part of the Monkeys. If the belt is not long enough to completely circle the trunk, you can either connect two belts or chose a longer one.

#### Footholds:

Do not use the upper part of the hold for your feet, but the tread of the Monkeys. This way, you can keep the holds free from dirt. You should use the less important holds on the bottom or even use Monkeys without holds. Wear sturdy shoes with a good edge strength! Check our shop for the most adequate.

## Below 3m (10 feet):

After you have fixed the first tension belt with the Monkeys in breast height, you need to help yourself with a trick.

If you stay below 3m (10feet), it suffices to just put a tension belt around your waist and use the provided carabiner to connect it with a tension belt that is already attached to the tree. This way you climb up the Monkeys until you can connect with the highest tension belt nearby the Monkey. Now you can act freely again, Add the next tension belt to the tree. After you have installed your complete equipment, you can start bouldering without any rope. To lower the danger of injury at a jump off, we explicitly point out that you should use a good and appropriate drop-absorbing mat (crashpad).

## Above 3m (10 feet):

From this point on, the sports climbing principles obtain and the safety regulations have to be kept! Fitting harnesses, certified carabiners, ropes and helmets provide the basis for your and your partner's safety! You have to secure your ascent with a runner on top of the route (use screw-lock carabiners for top-roping).

For the easy, functional setup of a tree, we recommend using our especially developed Monkey-backpack, the "OrangUtan" (p.30-31). Therein, the Monkeys, allen-key, slings etc. are arranged. On the outside, carabiners, eventually a saw and the like can be attached to the gear loops. Hang the backpack on the highest tension belt, because it is easier and more comfortable to pick the holds from there. For security reasons, secure it with a second carabiner and cord. One carabiner always has to stay closed while ascending, so the bag can't fall down and cause harm to others (via ferrata principle)!

We attach the unrolled tension belts with a cow hitch and another carabiner to the "OrangUtan".

## Following issues are of particular importance!

The use of Monkeys is a variety of rock climbing and should only be performed by skilled persons or with an instructor.

Without additional, climbing-specific protection, the use of Monkeys is permitted only up to a height of 3m (10 feet).

A crashpad (drop-absorbing mat) should always be used to avoid potential injuries.

Climbing equipment is subject to abrasion and should be checked permanently and renewed, if necessary.

Above 3m (10 feet): Concerning belaying, rappelling etc., the common rules of rock climbing obtain.

While dismounting the Monkeys, you should secure the tension belt before disengaging the clasp. In fact, the Monkeys feature a slip-guard that however might be overstrained under unfavorable circumstances (heavy holds, sudden releasing). While dismounting, nobody should remain in adjacency of the tree. A helmet is recommended!

For the visual protection of your Monkeys and your holds, it is recommended to wrap them individually after use.

We cannot be held liable at all for accidents which occur by the use of Monkeys.

# Calculate how high you can set up a MONKEY®-set

Example: I'm interested in the Monkey-Set "Basic". How high can I get with it?

#### 1. Define the gap in between the tension belts

- For children, the ideal gap in between the single tension belts is ca. 30-35cm.
- For adults, a gap of ca. 40-50cm is recommended.


#### 2. Check the content of the Set

- The height you can reach is defined by the quantity of tension belts included in a set.
- Set Basic includes 10 tension belts.
- With 10 tension belts you can reach a height of ca. 4 meters (10 x 0,4m = 4m).

#### 3. How to get higher?


There are several possibilities:

- With one of our Starter-sets you get ca. 80cm higher. The Starter-set includes 2 tension belts and 4 Monkeys. Those are used as footholds to start into the route, therefore you don't need holds on it.
- You can simply increase the gap in between the tension belts. The climbing will be more difficult then.
- More tension belts, Monkeys and holds can be added according to your wishes.
- In order to have fun, you don't have to climb high.
   You can set up the Monkeys around the lower
   parts of a tree, so that you can "boulder" (climbing
   in low heights) on it. We strongly recommend
   using a drop-absorbing mat ("crashpad") to avoid
   injuries.

## MONKEYS® in Nature – Rules and Tips:

To guaranty harmonic co-existence of humans, animals and plants and to avoid unnecessary limitation of climbing, you should follow some important rules:

- Respect parking prohibitions and only park on designated parking areas.
- Use marked trails whenever possible to preserve plants.
   Respect private property.
- Take home all your litter. Do not leave cigarette butts in the woods.
- Avoid noise (screaming, radio) that could disturb other humans and animals.
- Only climb on adequate trees. Make sure you do not hurt the tree. Do not cut off limbs.
- Do not climb trees that have nests in them. Disturbing birds while they are breeding may cause them to leave their offspring.
- If a tree has too many limbs, or you are not quite sure
  if it's stable enough to climb, find a better one to avoid
  any risk.
- Natural phenomenon cause changes on the trees. Avoid climbing those you are not absolutely confident about.

#### Following issues are of particular importance:

- The use of Monkeys is a variety of rock climbing and should only be performed by skilled persons or with an instructor.
- Without additional climbing-specific protection the use of Monkeys is permitted up to a height of 3m (10 feet).
- A crashpad (drop-absorbing mat) should always be used to avoid potential injuries.
- Climbing equipment is subject to abrasion and should be checked permanently and renewed, if necessary.
- Above 3m height, the rules and standards of sportsclimbing apply.
